RESTRAINTS

DO NOT exceed 3 m between bait stations for mice, or 9 m for rats.

DO NOT place baits in open.

Apply where pests occur in and around industrial commercial, agricultural and domestic buildings.	Rats	150 g per bait tray	Put measured quantity of bait in suitable containers, ie bait trays. Protect baits from water where possible. BAITING STRATEGY- Eliminate as far as practicable, all alternative food sources. Bait infested area. Place baits under cover. Inspect baits daily. Replace eaten baits. If eaten quickly increase number of baits. Continue observation and replenishment until no more baits are taken. Baiting for 2 weeks is necessary to reduce rat/mouse numbers.

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

PRECAUTION: DO NOT allow bait to contaminate foodstuffs or food intended for human or animal consumption. Do not apply bait to crops.

Place baits in locations which are inaccessible to other animals and birds. This product is hazardous to pigs, cats, dogs, native wildlife and poultry.

PROTECTION OF WILDLIFE, FISH, CRUSTACEANS AND ENVIRONMENT: DO NOT contaminate streams, rivers or waterways with the chemical or used containers. Place baits in locations inaccessible to animals other than target animals. The product is restricted to use in and around buildings (within 2 metres) or enclosed spaces.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL: Store in the closed, original container in a dry, cool, well-ventilated area out of direct sunlight.

If recycling, replace cap and return clean containers to recycler or designated collection point. If not recycling, break, crush or puncture and deliver empty packaging to an approved waste management facility. If an approved waste management facility is not available bury the empty packaging 500 mm below the surface in a disposal pit specifically marked and set up for this purpose clear of waterways, desirable vegetation and tree roots in compliance with relevant Local, State or Territory government regulations. DO NOT burn empty containers and product.

Dispose of carcasses safely by burning or burying in an approved landfill.
