

INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE:

1. Remove this insert from container.
2. Empty contents of sachet (fly attractant) into this container.
3. Add 600ml luke-warm water (NOT HOT) and mix for about one minute.
4. Place container in sunlight, out of wind and no more than 45cm from the ground, in the 'fly zone'.
5. Attractant requires an activation period generally around 24-48 hours before it becomes fully effective. Note: higher temperatures will activate faster.

RE-USE AND MAINTENANCE OF RENTOKIL JUMBO FLY TRAP

To get the best value from this system, we recommend you re-use this container. It is also important to maintain your Jumbo Fly Trap.

- Check your level of water – top up regularly and do not allow it to dry out.
- Discard dead flies as necessary or at least every three weeks.
- Use Rentokil Fly Trap Attractant replacement sachets to reset traps and re-use.
- For optimum hygiene, wash hands after use.

FLIES: DID YOU KNOW...

- One fly can carry 6 million bacteria on the outside and more than 25 million bacteria on the inside.
- Flies can have “population explosions” during periods of hot, humid conditions.
- The adult fly can live from 2-6 weeks and can begin to lay eggs within two days of maturity.
- Female houseflies can lay about 1000 eggs per batch and up to 12-14 batches during its lifespan.
- Flies can't eat solid food. To soften it up they vomit on it, stamp the vomit in until its liquid, then suck it all back again often dropping excrement at the same time.
- Flies like heat, light and low wind.
